Through slide show, hand-outs, and hands-on color exercises you will learn about mood, harmony, rhythm and color mixing. By the end of the class you will have greater skill and knowledge, your own resource guide, and palettes of color that are unique to you. There will be time to create your own paintings. All levels welcome.

Suzanne Jacquot earned a BFA at UC Berkeley in psychology and design, an MFA from Mills College in sculpture and photography, and an Art Therapy Certificate from Sonoma State University.
