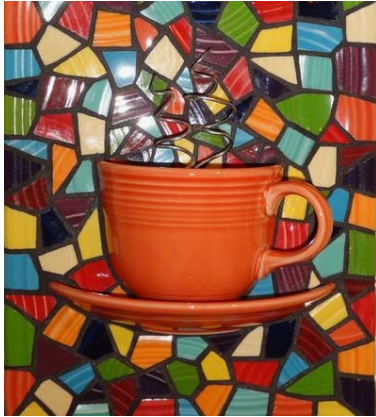


## Mosaics: Coffee mugs, planters and more

Learn to create mosaic art. This workshop will give you an opportunity to create a one of a kind mosaic piece using a coffee mug or tea cup to hold small plants or air plants. You will explore cutting techniques (including how to get a straight cut on the mug), adhesive choices, and design layout, and finish the piece with grouting techniques. I will have many mugs to choose from or if you have a favorite you're not using you can bring it along. Lots of fun with this one!

Leslie has been creating mosaic art for over 20 years with formal training from master mosaic artist Luciana Notturmi, in Ravenna, Italy. She is a member of The Society of American Mosaic Artists (SAMA) and regularly attends their annual mosaic convention held throughout the US. Her focus is on creating garden pieces and working on unique substrates. Leslie has been teaching mosaic art for over 8 years and enjoys seeing her students advance in mosaics.
