In this 2-day intensive abstract art workshop, open to all levels, we explore one of the most basic fundamentals of painting: composition/design/ dividing space/eye flow. Through focused fun studio exercises we will take risks, trust our own intuition, explore and push our edges of comfort, learn what is natural and pleasing for us and become more confident working in the unknown. We will also learn what makes a painting stronger, more alive and begin to paint bolder. There will be plenty of time for personal exploration. My goal is to help you strengthen your studio practice, to help you make more dynamic paintings and to express your own authentic creativity.

Suzanne Jacquot earned a BFA at UC Berkeley in psychology and design, an MFA from Mills College in sculpture and photography, and an Art Therapy Certificate from Sonoma State University.
